

Employment Opportunity: Incoming Music Archivist



Trent Radio invites applications from Trent University Students who are TWSP Eligible to fill the position of Incoming Music Archivist.

Trent Radio is a Community Broadcast Facility transmitting at 92.7 FM in Peterborough, ON. Established and operated by the students of Trent University, Trent Radio is designed with the production of exceptional radio in mind. Its aims and objects include producer oriented programming and broad community participation for the production of creative local radio.

The successful candidate will be eligible for Trent Work Study Program (TWSP) funding and be responsible for supporting the Director of Operations with assignments including sorting, accessioning and distributing all new music at Trent Radio, facilitate communications with Music Promoters and Trent Radio Programmers to fulfill Trent Radio's Incoming Music Policies.

The Incoming Music Archivist will become familiar with and involved in Peterborough's Local Music Scene, and will play a key role in encouraging local bands to submit their music to Trent Radio's Archives, and help promote this music on Trent Radio.

All Trent Radio Staff are expected to aid with day-to-day operations of the regular broadcast season, including occasional cleaning, programmer support and snow shoveling.

Eligibility & Qualifications

Must be TWSP eligible; enjoy meeting new people; have excellent organisational skills; enthusiasm in fostering community activity.
