Terms: Employment Period June 24 – August 17 (8 weeks, 35hrs/week)

Pay Rate: \$20.60/hour, plus 4% vacation pay, plus statutory benefits.

Flexible schedule required, evening and weekend shifts/assignments anticipated.

Eligibility:

The position is funded through Canada Summer Jobs, and the successful application must meet the following criteria in order to be eligible for the funding:

- a) is between 15 and 30 years of age (inclusive) at the start of employment;
- b) is a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act (International Students are not eligible) and;
- c) is legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial / territorial legislation and regulations.

Role & Responsibilities: The Summer Broadcast Journalist will work with Trent Radio staff and board members to produce locally-focused news content for broadcast at 92.7 CFFF-FM (Trent Radio). The Summer Broadcast Journalist will be an active member of Trent Radio's growth as a reliable local news source through the production of both live and pre-recorded content for broadcast with a focus on amplifying under-represented voices and perspectives.

The Summer Broadcast Journalist will also work as part of the Summer Operations Team to support the daily activities at Trent Radio House, including programming support shifts, radio projects and community gatherings, and production tasks as assigned.

This position requires a flexible schedule, including evening & weekend work.

Qualifications: Successful candidates will have some audio production experience; have excellent organisational and communication skills; experience creating media content including interviews and researching facts and information.
