Employment Opportunity at Trent Radio Indigenous Student Producer (TWSP Eligibility Required)

Contract: September 21, 2025 to April 18, 2026, 7 hours/week

Rate of pay: \$21.65/hour

Working as part of the Trent Radio Team, the Indigenous Student Producer will support the day-to-day operations at Trent Radio House by providing on-site support and guidance to volunteer producers including: radio monitoring, general house cleaning/snow shoveling, studio training, creative production support and compliance administration. Working independently, the Indigenous Student Producer will be responsible for producing weekly radio broadcast content to highlight, feature and promote the people and activities within Chanie Wenjak School of Indigenous Studies, as well as Indigenous students and student groups on campus.

The job will entail a weekly/regular on-site support shift, as well as independent production work for their radio show. (7hrs total per week)

Successful candidates should be eager to engage with community members and the Trent U community. All audio production training and gear will be provided. Reporting to the Director of Programming, the Local Content Producers will complete tasks each week with a blend of on-site, remote and event work hours (including possible evening & weekend shifts).
