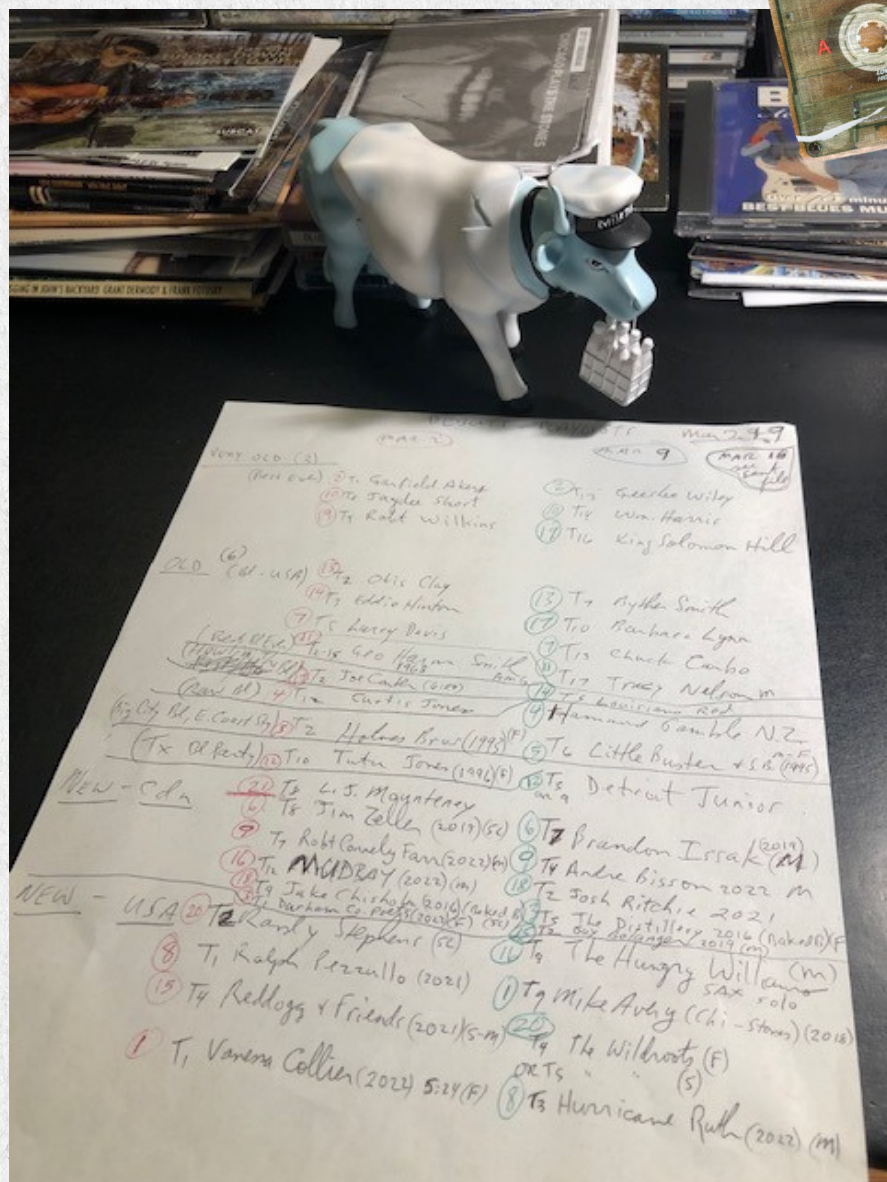

The Dying Body is Radio-Active: Radio is Weird, and You can be Too

By James Kerr, host of "Radio Drama Queen"

Radio is ephemeral, shooting out into the air in watts vertically and horizontally and then it is gone, vibrated out of existence. So too is our time at Trent Radio. For more than a decade Trent Radio CFFF 92.7 FM was effectively the broadcast centre of my life. But now there's a whole new crew of folks who don't know me, and have maybe only heard my voice in what is now an old and dusty station ID.

It is in this spirit that I started my show Radio Drama Queen, dredging up the long-forgotten dramas of yesteryear in the hope that someone new might connect with the material. Like me, these dramas were important to radio, once upon a time. And In this act I've been able to selfishly reconnect with my love of an obscure old medium of storytelling.

"Oh, radio, you've done it to me again," I say. "I've fallen in love! Radio, someone still loves you!"

Yes, it's a little weird-okay, more than a little weird. At least there is a community here, of weirdos. In this life there has to be some non-commercial space. Somewhere where what we say is not metered and gauged and calculated for maximum what-not. (Even if it must be accounted for under foreground format and reported appropriately to the CRTC.) That place is here, Trent Radio, thank goodness gracious.

"Trent Radio, my love," I say. "My heart stays with you, even as my body has decayed into radio waves, bouncing between stars in 600 watts vertical and 600 watts horizontal! All that is left of me is echoes, reverb, and love."

Programmers, treasure your time on the terrestrial airwaves. Like our time on earth, it is morbidly brief. And if you want to indulge me, please do tune in to Radio Drama Queen, Wednesdays at 1:30 PM EST (Earth Standard Time, of course) and drift...drift dear listener, back to the sounds of yesterday; just at the limit of your listening ears, and at the edge of illusion.
